

## **COLLECTION NOTICE #2**

**CLIENT:** Ms. Penelope Jones

**AMOUNT OWED:** \$2.75

**PERSON/COMPANY RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT:** "Skitchy" (real name unknown)

**CONTACT INFORMATION:** No known address or phone number.

**DETAILS:** Ms. Penelope Jones was walking on St. Laurent Boulevard on June 12 around 2 pm, when the street was closed to traffic for the F1 Grand Prix Street Party. Ms. Jones was approached by a scruffy-looking man who announced himself as "Skitchy". He proceeded to tell her a sob story about how he needed \$2.75 to take the metro because "his wallet was stolen". He promised to repay her as soon as possible. Ms. Jones loaned him the requested amount (\$2.75) and asked him to repay it later, leaving her contact details. "Skitchy" never called back. There are currently rumours that he is telling other people on the street the same sob story, that his goal is to collect money for himself and that he has no intention of ever repaying anyone. When Ms. Jones heard the rumours, she contacted our agency to collect. She is offering a 10% commission (rounded up to 28 €).
